When travelling with the attachment for a mobility aid, the following requirements must be met:

- the device containing the battery must be removed from the mobility aid;
- the device must be turned off and protected from accidental activation;
- all terminals of any spare batteries must be individually protected to prevent short circuiting (e.g., taped); and
- the spare batteries must be protected from damage (e.g. each battery in a protective bag or pouch).

You will need to carry your Smartdrive mobility device and spare batteries as:
